# CHRISTMAS TRAIL

A festive appeal from the Community Council

Our Christmas Trail was so well received last year that we hope to repeat it in 2021, getting together as a community and bringing a little seasonal cheer to the local streets.

It's not too late to set your Christmas creativity free and volunteer yourself to participate in one (or indeed all) of the following to create a Christmassy trail around the village that can be enjoyed by us all.



## Advent Windows

From 1st to 24th December windows around the village will be decorated and 'opened' each day. It's not too late to join in the fun - there are a few slots remaining. You just need to incorporate the number you are given and have a window that can clearly be seen from the street which will be illuminated each evening from when it is opened until after Christmas. Advent windows must ready to be revealed on the date allocated.

## Christmas Tree Trail

If you decorate a beautiful tree every year and want the opportunity to show it off then here is your chance. The design and decoration is down to you. All we ask is that your tree is clearly visible from the street and you supply a simple question eg. What's on the top? for a children's trail. Trees must be displayed from Friday 10th December.



## Wreath competition

The only requirement is that you decorate your wreath yourself so feel free to be as creative as you like. There will be three categories: Adult; Child (under 16); and child (under 10). The competition will be judged and the results announced on 21st December. Wreaths must be displayed from Friday 10th December.
